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Project Overview:

Evans Jones was appointed by the Royal Free London NHS Foundation Trust to conduct Disabled Access Audits on its three hospitals: Royal Free Hospital, Barnet Hospital and Chase Farm Hospital, along with 15 other regional clinics. The brief was to deliver audits covering the hospitals' public areas, including visitor entrances, lifts, stairs and C toilet facilities.

Challenges:

The main challenge was to deliver the programme of audits in a consistent manner, across a short time frame. The NHS Trust were looking for clear, practical recommendations, based on a detailed knowledge of the legal requirements.
