Project Overview:

WWT (Wildfowl and Wetlands Trust) commissioned Evans Jones to carry out a Disabled Access Audit of the grounds and visitor facilities at Slimbridge Wetland Centre. Consistent with founder, Sir Peter Scott's, vision of connecting people with nature, Slimbridge make it a principle that their wetlands and wildlife are accessible to everyone. With this priority in mind, Evans Jones were commissioned to carry out a Disabled Access Audit of the grounds and visitor facilities at the Centre. This work was required as a key element of a Heritage Lottery Fund bid, which will enable WWT to provide new exhibits and visitor facilities at Slimbridge.

Challenges:
